RULES and REGULATIONS

ENTRIES: Entries close on Tuesday prior to the show. NO FAX OR PHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. All entry forms must be signed by the owner or his/her authorized agent and trainer, and accompanied by a check for all fees. Make Checks payable to Meadowview Farm, Inc. All checks must be signed. All riders must have a signed entry form in the show office before they school in any ring. A flat post entry fee of \$20.00 will be charged for those not entered by 6 p.m. Tuesday prior to the show. A processing fee of \$40.00 plus collection fees will be made for all nonnegotiable checks. MHJA Horse Show Evaluation Forms are available in the Secretary's Stand (Show Office). Please include copies of all MHJA memberships. Entry fees are refundable only when a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the show secretary prior to the class/classes involved. No stall refunds will be given .

STABLING: Stall fees are \$80.00 per stall. Stalls must be paid in full to guarantee the reservation. Stalls will be available Friday prior to the show after 9:00 AM, and horses arriving before that time will be charged an additional \$10.00 per day. Arrangements for early arrivals must be made in advance with the Stable Manager. Stabling consists of 10' x 10' wooden stalls with doors in the permanent buildings, and portable stabling with stall guards in the indoor ring. Horses showing from trailers may do so only with permission of Management. NON-SHOWING HORSES stabled on the grounds must have a COMPLETED and SIGNED ENTRY BLANK on file in the show office BEFORE SCHOOLING and will be charged a \$75.00 non-showing fee. If you enter a class and scratch you will be considered a non-showing horse, unless you have a veterinarian's certificate from the on call veterinarian.

SCHOOLING: Schooling will be available during the following times (subject to change). FRI: 12-dark, SAT: 6:00-7:00am, SUN 6:00-7:00am. All courses will be set on a 12' stride measurement. Please Note: No schooling allowed over Medal courses.

MEDIC: Will be on duty all show days. Medic fees are \$10.00 per rider for the show.

HEADGEAR: ALL riders MUST wear approved headgear (ASTM/SEI certified helmet) with the harness secured while mounted on the show grounds.

CAMPING: Camper fees are \$80.00 per weekend, with any addition nights \$10.00. Space is extremely limited and you must reserve a space in advance, by telephone.

DOGS: NO DOGS ALLOWED! Visiting dogs are a disturbance to our exhibitors, so please leave your dogs at home or kennel them nearby,

PONY MEASUREMENT: There is a \$20.00 measurement fee for ALL ponies. No one is exempt from this measurement fee. The measurement fee and the measurement form are then emailed to the MHJA office where a measurement card will be issued and mailed to the owner. A scheduled measure time will be posted.

GENERAL NOTES: An order of go will be posted and followed in all Medal and Jumper classes. This will help riders and trainers in their warm up, promote prompt entry into the ring and will help expedite the show. In some cases the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring. If entries warrant, the class schedule and arenas may be altered to accommodate a one judge show. NO SMOKING IN THE BARN OR THE INDOOR ARENA AREAS!

WARNING Under the Michigan Equine Activity Liability Act, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of participant in an equine activity resulting from an inherent risk of the equine activity.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

A rider who is eligible to compete in a division at the start of the show year will remain eligible to compete in that division for the remainder of the show year regardless of the # of blue ribbons he/ she may have won. Winning 30 USEF Points will make a rider IMMEDIATELY INELIGIBLE for certain divisions.

PONY HUNTERS

PONY DIVISIONS: Ponies must be ridden by junior riders. No rider over 12 years of age may compete on a small pony and no rider over 14 years of age may compete on a medium pony with the exception of the Unrestricted Pony Hunter division. Ponies must have a current measurement card in order to compete in any pony class.

Pony Warm-Ups: Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. Entry fee \$22.00.

Small/Medium Pony Hunter Division: Entry fee \$22.00. Open to ponies of any age. Small ponies may not exceed 12.2 hands in height; Medium ponies must exceed 12.2 hands and may not exceed 13.2 hands in height. Small - 2'; Medium - 2'3"

Large Pony Hunter Division: Entry fee \$22.00. Open to ponies exceeding 13.2 hands and not exceeding 14.2 hands in height. Fences 2'9"

UNRESTRICTED CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER: Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. There is no age restriction for pony size other than rider must be a junior. Fences: Large - 2'6"; Small/ Med.- 2'

CHILDREN'S LARGE PONY HUNTER DIVISION: Open to junior riders mounted on large ponies. Riders may cross enter in MHJA Open divisions for the current show year. Riders become ineligible the following show year to compete in the Children's Pony Division. Fences 2'6". No In & Out.

CHILDREN'S SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER DIVISION: Open to junior riders mounted on small and medium ponies. Riders may cross enter in MHJA Open divisions for the current show year. Riders become ineligible the following show year to compete in the Children's Pony Division. Fences 2'. No In & Out.

NOVICE PONY HUNTER DIVISION: Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won three blue ribbons in hunter classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. This division is not open to any rider who has shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA and USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Open divisions include: MHJA & USEF Pony Medals and Small, Medium or Large Pony Hunter Divisions, Pony Equitation 12 & Under or 13-17 years, Junior Hunters, Junior Equitation 14 & Under or 15-17 years, MHJA Open Junior Medal, and USEF Medal classes. Riders having won in the Novice Pony Hunter Division do not lose their Children's Pony Hunter status. Fences 2' for all. No In & Out or oxers.

SHORT STIRRUP PONY HUNTER DIVISION: Open to junior riders 11 years and under. These riders may not have won nine blue ribbons in recognized hunter classes over fences at MHJA, MHSA or USEF Shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year, but riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the current show year. The rider cannot jump in classes that require the rider to jump higher than 2'3". Riders having won in the Short Stirrup Division do not lose their Novice status. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA and USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. For a list of Open divisions, see Short Stirrup Equitation description. Fences: Large Ponies - 2'; Small/Medium - 18". No In & Out and no tests.

PONY EQUITATION 12 YEARS & UNDER: Open to junior riders 12 & under mounted on ponies. Fences: Large Ponies - 2'9"; Medium - 2'3"; Small - 2'. Tests 1-9 over fences; 1-5, 8, 9 on the flat (Rule XIV).

PONY EQUITATION 13-17 YEARS: Open to junior riders 13-17 mounted on ponies. Fences: Large Ponies - 2'9"; Medium - 2'3". Tests 1-9 over fences; 1-5, 8, 9 on the flat (Rule XIV).

CHILDREN'S PONY EQUITATION: Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won six blue ribbons in equitation over fences classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member show. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup or Novice Pony Equitation divisions do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 30 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF Shows. Winning 30 USEF points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. This section will be split into two divisions: Riders on Large Ponies and riders on Small/Medium. Riders may NOT cross enter in both divisions. Fences: Large - 2'6"; Small/Medium - 2'. No In & Outs, no tests. Only the rider to be judged.

NOVICE RIDDEN PONY EQUITATION: Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won three blue ribbons over fences in equitation classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in the Short Stirrup Division do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF shows. Winning 15 USEF points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders may not cross enter into the open equitation divisions. Fences 2' for all. No In & Out and no oxers or tests.

SHORT STIRRUP PONY EQUITATION: Open to junior riders 11 years and under who have not won three blue ribbons in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF Shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Ribbons won in equitation on the flat classes do not affect a rider's eligibility in equitation classes over fences. However, ribbons won in equitation over fences classes do affect a rider's eligibility on the flat. Riders CANNOT jump in classes that require the rider to jump higher than 2'3". Qualified riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the current Show Year. In addition, this division is not open to any riders who have shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA and USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Open divisions include: MHJA & USEF Pony Medals and Small, Medium, Large or Children's Pony Hunter Divisions, Pony Equitation 12 & Under or 13-17 years, Junior Hunters, Junior Equitation 14 & Under or 15-17 years, MHJA Open Junior Medal, and USEF Medal classes. Fences: Large Ponies - 2'; Small/ Medium - 18". No In & Out and no tests. Riders in walk/trot classes are not permitted to enter any classes over fences.

MHJA PONY MEDAL: Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. To be shown over a figure eight course of not less than six obstacles. Course must include one combination and two changes of direction. The fence heights shall be 2' for small ponies, 2'3" for medium ponies and 2'9" for large ponies. To fill the class four competitors must compete. To qualify for the Final Medal Ride-Off a competitor must win one Blue or one Red Ribbon. Riders qualifying by winning one Red may still continue to compete. Two tests of the top four riders is required. Tests 1-19. One rider per pony.

MHJA PONY MINI-MEDAL: Open to junior riders mounted on ponies, which has not shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions. Course will be set up like an equitation course with no in and outs or oxers. Fence heights: 2' for all ponies and distances set on 12' stride. May not be combined with the Pony Medal. Tests 1-6. One rider per pony. Judges encouraged to test the top 4 riders.

"C" CIRCUIT CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

WARM-UP CLASSES: Entry fee \$18.00 per Class. Open to all Horses and riders.

VERY GREEN HUNTER: Entry Fee: \$22.00 Per Class

Open to horses in their first year or second year of showing over fences. Horses may cross enter into the Regular member Baby Green Hunter division. Horses may show in baby green/very green for two show seasons and after that will be ineligible to compete in either division the following show season. Fence Heights: 2'3" - 2'6"

PRIMARY JUNIOR/ADULT HUNTER: Entry Fee: \$22.00 Per Class. Open to Junior/Adult riders who have not won 6 Blue Ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Competing in any classes 2'9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Ribbons won in Over Fences classes DO affect a rider's eligibility on the flat. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. Fence Heights: 2'3"

INTERMEDIATE JUNIOR/ADULT HUNTER: Entry Fee: \$22.00 Per Class. Open to Junior/Adult riders who have not won 9 Blue Ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Competing in any classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Ribbons won in Over Fences classes DO affect a rider's eligibility on the flat. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. Fence Heights: 2'6"

BEGINNER JUNIOR/ADULT HUNTER : Entry Fee \$22.00 Per Class. Open to Junior/Adult riders who have not won three blue ribbons in a recognized hunter class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Beginner status for the current show season. This Rule to supersede all other rules. Riders having won in the Beginner Junior/Adult division do not lose their Novice, Primary or Short Stirrup status. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions at MHJA, MHSA or USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Riders may not cross enter into any division that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. No Oxers or In & Out. Fences: 2'

BEGINNER JUNIOR/ADULT EQUITATION: Entry Fee \$22.00 Per Class. Open to Junior/Adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Beginner status for the current show season. This Rule supersedes all other rules. Riders having won in the Beginner Adult or Junior division do not lose their Novice, Primary or Short Stirrup status. Ribbons won in equitation on the flat classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in equitation over fences classes DO affect a rider's eligibility on the flat. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions at MHJA, MHSA or USEF Pony or Regular member shows. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. No Oxers or In & Out. Fences: 2'

PRIMARY JUNIOR/ADULT EQUITATION: Entry Fee: \$22.00 Per Class. Open to Junior/Adult riders who have not won 6 Blue Ribbons in any equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation On the Flat classes do not affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation Over Fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation Over Fences classes do affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation On the Flat classes. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. Competing in any classes 2'9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences: 2'3"

INTERMEDIATE JUNIOR / ADULT EQUITATION: Entry Fee: \$22.00 Per Class. Open to all Junior/Adult riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation On The Flat classes do not affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation Over Fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation Over Fences classes do affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation On the Flat classes. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. Competing in any classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences: 2'6"

MHJA INTERMEDIATE JUNIOR MEDAL: Entry Fee: \$25.00. Open to all Junior Riders who have not won 9 Blue Ribbons in any equitation classes over fences. Competing in any classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this Medal. To qualify for the final Medal Ride-Off a rider must win one Blue Ribbon or one Red Ribbon in a qualifying class. Riders winning two Blue Ribbons are then ineligible to compete in the qualifying classes. Riders winning one Red Ribbon may continue to compete in the qualifying classes until they win a Blue Ribbon. To be shown over a figure eight course of not less than six fences, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. Four competitors must compete in the class. Tests 1-8. MHJA Qualifying Medal & 6 Ribbons. Fence Heights: 2'6"

MHJA INTERMEDIATE ADULT MEDAL: Entry Fee: \$25.00. Open to amateur riders ONLY, who have not won 9 Blue Ribbons in any equitation class. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. Competing in any class 3' or higher will immediately make a rider ineligible to compete in this Medal. The top 15 point accumulators in this class during the season will qualify to compete in the Medal Finals. Fence Heights: 2'6"

MHJA JUNIOR/ADULT MINI MEDAL: Entry Fee: \$25.00. Open to Junior/Adult riders who have not won three blue ribbons in a recognized Equitation class at MHJA- MHSA-USEF show prior to October 1 of the preceding year. Ribbons won in equitation on the flat classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in equitation over fences classes DO affect a rider's eligibility on the flat. Ribbons won in MHJA junior classes DO affect an adult rider's eligibility. Riders do retain their status for the current show season. Riders having won do not lose their Novice- Primary-Short Stirrup status. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions at MHJA- MHSA- USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this class. Top 15 point accumulators in this class during the season will qualify to compete in the Medal Finals. 1/2 points will be awarded if there are less than 3 competitors. No oxers or In & Out. Fence Heights: 2'

LEAD LINE: Entry fee \$22.00. Informal attire permitted. Riders will be asked to walk and halt on a lead line. They may be asked to demonstrate the two-point or be asked a simple question.

WALK /TROT: Entry fee \$22.00. Beginner walk trot diagonals do not count. Informal attire permitted. Not MHJA recognized.

CROSSPOLE HUNTER & EQUITATION: Entry Fee: \$22.00 Per Class. Open to very beginner riders. Single jumps only on the diagonal. Riders may cross enter into the Beginning Hunter ONLY. Fence Heights: Crosspoles.

PONY HUNTER PRIX: Entry Fee:\$25. 2 Judges will judge first round over at least 10 fences. Numerical scores given. Course will be built using both show rings with track going from ring to ring. Riders choose 2' without oxers or 2' or 2'6" oxers included. Please declare with the starter. Posted order of go will be posted. Obstacles will include Natural type as well as show ring type obstacles. Will include bending lines, unrelated distance line, long run. Top 12 scores will return for Second Round, the Handy round. Will be shown over at least 8 obstacles, options available to show hand hunter abilities, hand gallop, trot, walk. In addition to Judges score, Handy points can be awarded from 0-10 possible. Trophy and 12 ribbons awarded. Ride for ribbons encouraged with a safe aspect!!!
